This year the University of Barcelona will offer twelve international courses in specialized fields related to business and economics, health sciences, data analysis and social sciences. The courses will allow participants to combine rigorous training and scientific excellence with a unique international experience.

These multidisciplinary courses, taught in English, are offered over one to three weeks, and are open to all international participants, with a focus on students and professionals who wish to gain further knowledge. The courses will be carried out on the premises of the iconic Historic Building of the University of Barcelona, in the heart of the city, and or other interesting urban locations.

The city of Barcelona represents an ideal framework for the University of Barcelona International Summer School. It offers the opportunity to participants to enjoy an environment very rich in cultural events and exciting urban life.

The fact that the academic offer is composed mainly by one-week courses gives our participants the possibility to enroll in two or even three consecutive courses, receiving a maximum amount of 6 ECTS.

The Summer School offer can be complemented by a Spanish Language and Culture courses program. These courses start the 6th, the 13th and the 20th of July and take place in the afternoon and its schedule does not coincide with the Summer School courses schedule.

SOCIAL PROGRAM

DISCOUNTS AND ADVANTAGES

The University of Barcelona International Summer School has a system of discounts that can reduce significantly the tuition fees

- 20% Early bird discount (until the 1st of April).
- 10% discount for UB members or members of UB partners.

Moreover, University of Barcelona International Summer School participants can use Internet connection free of charge, and have access to a large number of campus services.

Scholarships are available for our special partners; the University of Barcelona has agreements with several Higher Education Institutions to waive the fee of the International Summer Courses. Please ask your institution at the international office if there is such agreement available.



REGISTRATION

Registration to the University of Barcelona International Summer School will be open in February 22nd. In order to pre-register or receive a letter of acceptance you are requested to contact summerschool@ub.edu and mention the courses you are interested in.

Be advised that in case of visa application the following items will be required:

- 1) Proof of Health Insurance
- 2) Invitation letter

The University of Barcelona International Summer School reserves the right to cancel a course if there are not enough participants registered. In this case, students can register at other courses with spaces available or ask for a refund.
